Match background

With Salzburg setting the pace at the top of Group G, the pressure is on Sevilla and LOSC Lille to keep in touch as they meet again in Spain, where the French side have never won.

- The pair played out a goalless draw in northern France on Matchday 3, denying both clubs a first win in this season's UEFA Champions League and leaving Sevilla on three points, four behind Salzburg, with LOSC and Wolfsburg both on two.
- LOSC opened with a 0-0 draw at home to Wolfsburg before going down 2-1 at Salzburg, one of only two games in the section not to have ended all square. Sevilla drew 1-1 at home to Salzburg in a game that featured four penalties – a competition record – before their visit to Wolfsburg ended 1-1 thanks to Ivan Rakitić's late spot kick, his second in successive matches.

Previous meetings

- The sides' three previous meetings before Matchday 3, all in the UEFA Cup, came between December 2004 and March 2006 and all ended in a home win.
- Matt Moussilou's 77th-minute goal earned LOSC a 1-0 victory on Matchday 5 of the 2004/05 competition, a result that gave the French side first place in Group H ahead of runners-up Sevilla.
- LOSC also won 1-0 in the home leg of their meeting with Sevilla in the following season's round of 16, Geoffrey Dernis scoring the only goal in the 24th minute. Sevilla recovered to win the tie thanks to second-leg goals from Frédéric Kanouté (29) and Luís Fabiano (45+2) in Spain and went on to claim the first of their record six titles in the UEFA Cup/UEFA Europa League.

Form guide

Sevilla

- Sevilla are in the UEFA Champions League group stage for the seventh time, and the fifth in the last seven seasons. They have qualified for the knockout phase in all but one of their participations.
- In 2020/21, Julen Lopetegui's team finished second in Group E behind eventual champions Chelsea, picking up 13 points – one fewer than the English club. Sevilla then lost to Borussia Dortmund in the round of 16 (2-3 h, 2-2 a).
- Sevilla's wins in their first two home UEFA Champions League matches last season are their only victories in their last eight games in the competition at their own ground (D3 L3).
- Fourth in Spain for the second season in a row in 2020/21, Sevilla won their section in each of their first two UEFA Champions League campaigns and, after finishing third in 2015/16 – when they went on to complete a hat-trick of UEFA Europa League wins – they have been group runners-up in their three most recent seasons in the competition.
- Sevilla lost their second home game against French visitors, 0-1 to Paris Saint-Germain in the 2010/11 UEFA Champions League group stage, but have won the other three – all without conceding.
- Home and away, Sevilla are unbeaten in their last five matches against French sides (W3 D2), defeating Rennes 1-0 at the Estadio Ramón Sánchez-Pizjuán last season after a 3-1 win that was their first success in France.

LOSC

- This is LOSC's seventh UEFA Champions League group stage campaign, but just their second in the past nine seasons.
- Les Dogues' last appearance came in 2019/20, when they finished bottom of a section that also included Valencia, Chelsea and Ajax. LOSC lost five of their six games, the exception a 1-1 draw at home to Valencia on Matchday 3.
- Only one of those previous six campaigns has extended into the knockout phase, in 2006/07 when they lost 1-0 home and away against Manchester United in the round of 16.
- In 2020/21, LOSC's European campaign began in the UEFA Europa League group stage, where they finished second in their section behind AC Milan on 11 points, recording a notable 3-0 away win against the Rossoneri to help them finish above Sparta Praha and Celtic.
- LOSC's campaign was ended by Ajax in the round of 32, the Amsterdam club winning 2-1 in both France and the Netherlands.
- LOSC have lost six of their last seven away games in the UEFA Champions League group stage (W1), including each of the last four, and nine of their last 13 away European matches (W2 D2).
- LOSC claimed their fourth Ligue 1 title, and first since 2010/11, last season, finishing a point clear of Paris Saint-Germain. Their tally of 83 points was the highest in the club's history; LOSC suffered only three league defeats all season.

- Those two home wins against Sevilla are LOSC's only victories in their 14 previous matches against Spanish sides (D6 L6). Most recently before this season they faced Valencia in the 2019/20 UEFA Champions League group stage, Jonathan Ikoné's 95th-minute penalty rescuing a 1-1 home draw before a 4-1 loss in Spain.
- That reverse at Valencia made LOSC's record in Spain D1 L5, a 1-1 draw at Deportivo La Coruña on their first visit, in the 2001/02 UEFA Champions League first group stage, the sole occasion they have avoided defeat.

Latest news

Sevilla

- Matchday 3 was Fernando's 100th appearance in UEFA club competition and Óliver Torres' 50th match.
- Sevilla were 5-3 winners at home to Levante on 24 October, the first time they had scored five goals in a Liga game since a 5-0 home victory against Rayo Vallecano on 25 April 2019.
- Torres opened the scoring against Levante, his first goal since 30 June 2020.
- Rafa Mir was also on target and has four goals in his last seven league matches.
- Sevilla drew 1-1 at Mallorca on 27 October, summer signing Erik Lamela scoring for the first time in 11 matches having hit three in his first two games for Sevilla.
- Julen Lopetegui's side were 2-0 winners at home to Osasuna on Saturday, making it five Liga victories in as many games at the Estadio Ramón Sánchez Pizjuán this season, their joint best start to a campaign since an eight-game winning streak at the beginning of 2006/07.
- The weekend win was Lopetegui's 50th in the Liga as Sevilla coach, in his 87th match (D21 D16); he is the fastest to the mark in the club's history, beating Manolo Jiménez's previous best of 91.
- A 1-0 loss at Granada on 3 October is Sevilla's only defeat in 14 games in all competitions this season (W7 D6).
- Youssef En-Nesyri was a late substitute on Saturday, his first appearance since scoring in a 2-0 home win against Espanyol on 25 September due to a hamstring problem.
- Alejandro Gómez and Karim Rekik have been out since Matchday 3.

LOSC

- The French champions have managed only five victories in their 16 games in all competitions in 2021/22 (D5 L6), drawing two in a row before conceding twice in the final 16 minutes to go down 2-1 at Paris Saint-Germain on Friday night.
- A 2-0 win at home to Marseille on 3 October – LOSC's third successive league victory – is their only one in six games in all competitions (D2 L3).
- Jonathan David scored LOSC's goal in 1-1 home draw against Brest on 23 October, and at Paris on Friday, meaning he has provided their last four goals and six of the last seven.
- The draw at Brest was the first Ligue 1 game in which David scored that LOSC had failed to win, after victories in the first 15; Paris was therefore the first defeat.
- David has scored eight of LOSC's 15 league goals in 2021/22 and is Ligue 1's top scorer.
- David has also scored LOSC's last six league goals, the third player to achieve that feat for the club after Fernand

Devlaminck in 1957 and Bernard Bureau in 1986.

- Only Kylian Mbappé, with 20, has scored more than David's 19 Ligue 1 goals in 2021.
- LOSC's total of 15 points after 12 games is eight less than at the same stage of last season.
- LOSC have conceded 18 league goals so far; after 12 games in 2020/21, they had let in eight.
- LOSC ended Paris's run of eight successive French Super Cup wins on 1 August, Xeka scoring the only goal to give his side their first victory in the competition. LOSC were runners-up in 1955 and 2011.
- Sven Botman has not played since suffering a groin injury in the Netherlands' 5-0 home win against Wales in 2023 UEFA European Under-21 Championship qualifying on 12 October.
